This Show is affiliated to the Equifest Showing Show, taking place at the East of England Showground on the 19th – 13th August 2020. The **two** highest exhibits not already qualified in each affiliated class will qualify.

TSR RIDERS CHAMPIONSHIP

TSR SHOWING FINALS - This show is a qualifier for the 2020 TSR Regional Finals. Qualify and enter ANY of the Regional Finals Central, East Anglia, North West, North East, South East, South, Wales & South West or Scottish. You Do Not have to be a TSR member to qualify or enter a final. The Rider/Handler qualifies and can enter any horse/pony in any number of Finals!

TSR RIDERS FINALS - 1st & 2nd riders qualify and will receive a qualification card in the ring.

TSR IN HAND FINALS - The two highest placed Handlers with a TSR In Hand Card will qualify in any In Hand class. Handlers MUST have their cards signed in the ring by the judge/steward, cards are available FREE from the TSR website. Full details at <http://www.theshowingregister.co.uk/>

- 2 SPILLERS MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND
Open to M & M horses/ponies registered with their respective Pure Breed Societies. Class will be split if entries warrant.
- 3 BSPA/EQUIFEST PAINTS, SPOTS, DUNS, PALOMINOS & ROANS
Open to horses and ponies. To be judged on manners, colour & condition. **(Piebald/Skewbald ONLY will qualify for BSPA/Equifest)**
- 4 FOREIGN BREED INCL. ARABS
Open to horses/ponies.
- 5 VETERAN
15 years and over. (16 & over to qualify for Trailblazers)
- 6 COB/MAXI/TRADITIONAL
Any age. Open to horses & ponies.

CHAMPIONSHIP: 1st & 2nd from classes 1 - 6 to compete.

RIDDEN Not before 11.30am

- 7 CAVERNOMA ALLIANCE UK M & M LEADING REIN
Mare or gelding 4 years & over not exceeding 132cms. Riders not to have attained their 10th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Lead rein to be attached to the noseband. Snaffle bridles only.
Rosettes to all entrants
- 8 NOVICE PONY WALK & TROT
4 yrs & over not exceeding 148cms. Riders any age. Pony/rider combination not to have been placed 1st more than twice in a ridden showing class. Canter optional in individual show.
- 9 RIDDEN MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND
Open to M & M ponies 4 years & over registered with their respective Pure Breed Societies. Stallion, Mare or Gelding.
- 10 BSPA EQUIFEST RIDDEN PAINTS, SPOTS, DUNS, PALOMINOS & ROANS
Open to horses and ponies. Rider any age. To be judged on conformation, manners & colour.
(Piebald/Skewbald ONLY will qualify for BSPA/Equifest)
- 11 BEST JUNIOR RIDER
Horse or pony 4 years & over. Rider not to be over 16 years old.

CHAMPIONSHIP: 1st & 2nd from classes 7 - 11 to compete.

- 12 NOVICE HORSE WALK & TROT
4 yrs & over. Riders any age. Horse/rider combination not to have been placed 1st more than twice in a ridden showing class. Canter optional in individual show.
- 13 BLACK COUNTRY SADDLES RIDDEN HUNTER/B CRABTREE AGRI SERVICES SMALL HUNTER
Mare or gelding 4 years & over. Exceeding 148cms. Small Hunter not to exceed 158cms
- 14 NUPAFEEED RIDING HORSE
Mare or gelding 4 years & over. Exceeding 148cms
- 15 RIDDEN VETERANS
Mare or gelding (16 & over to qualify for Trailblazers)
- 16 TRADITIONAL COB
4 yrs old & over to be shown in full feather & un-plaited.
- 17 FOREIGN BREED INCL. ARABS
Horse or pony 4 years and over.
- 18 NUPAFEEED RIDDEN COB/EQUIFEST MAXI COB
Mare or gelding 4 years & over.
1st – 6th rosette in each section if split.
